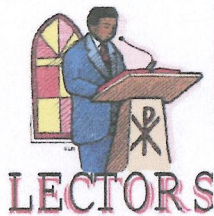

**Eucharistic Adoration this week**

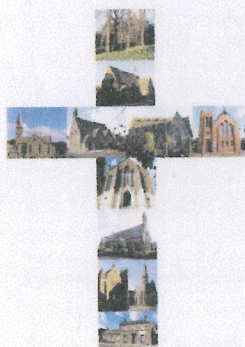

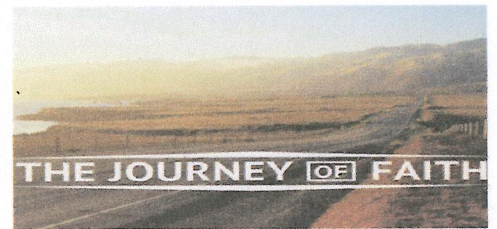
