week. The highlight for me was reconnecting with
a guy who'd been in Blairs with me in the 1970s

was remarkable was how we were able to pick up

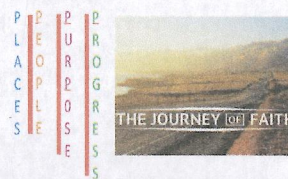
St Clement's & St Ninian's Pilgrimage and Leisure Trip to India.
