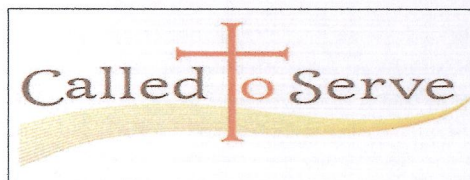


Cathedral Dinner for young people
