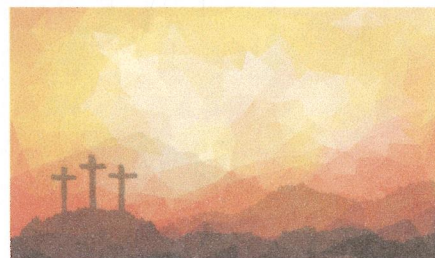


Please plan ahead now so that you can do your very best to keep the Easter Feast with us in your parish community.

Holy Week begins with the Lord's entry into the holy city of Jerusalem on Sunday 24 March.

The **Easter Triduum** opens with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday 28 March; it continues with the celebration of the Passion on Good Friday 29 March and climaxes in the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday night, 30 March.

The Easter Triduum includes the solemn and joyful Mass of Easter Day and formally concludes with Evening Prayer and Benediction on Easter Sunday afternoon, 31 March, which we shall celebrate at 4pm in the Cathedral.
