Please **Don't** miss the Triduum;

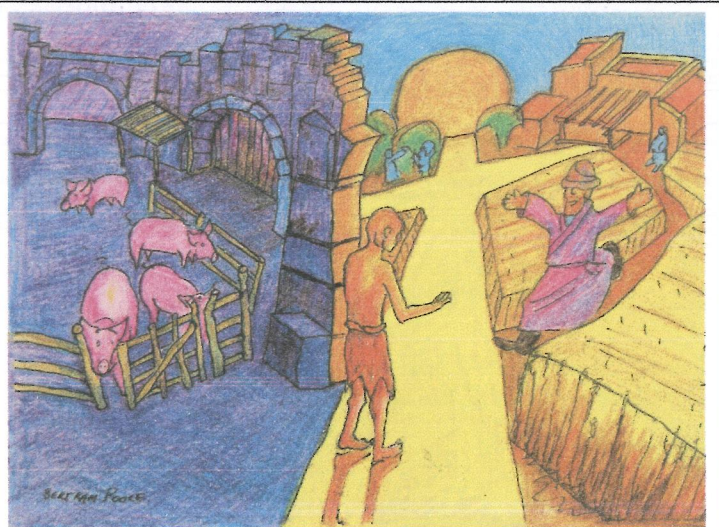
Please **Don't** minimise the Triduum by skipping any part of it - the Easter Vigil is the climax;
