



This being SCIAF Sunday we take the annual collection for

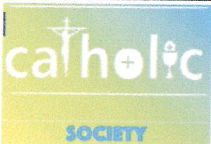

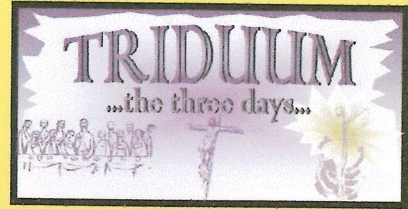

**Preparing for the Easter Triduum**



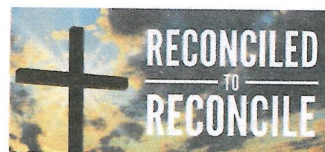
