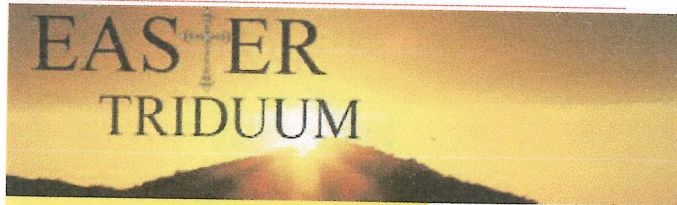


The Mass of Chrism & Renewal of Commitment to Priestly Service

The Easter Triduum in St Andrew's Cathedral

Holy Thursday of the Lord's Supper 17 April

Office of Readings and Morning Prayer at 10am in the Cathedral.

Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7pm, followed by procession to the Altar of Repose and Night Prayer at 9pm.

Good Friday of the Lord's Passion 18 April

Office of Readings and Morning Prayer at 10am in the Cathedral.

Solemn Liturgy of the Passion at 3pm.
Stations of the Cross at 7.30pm

Holy Saturday at the Lord's Tomb 19 April

Office of Readings and Morning Prayer at 10am in the Cathedral.

The Easter Vigil is at 8.30pm.

The Easter Triduum opens with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday and continues until Evening Prayer (Vespers) on Easter Sunday.

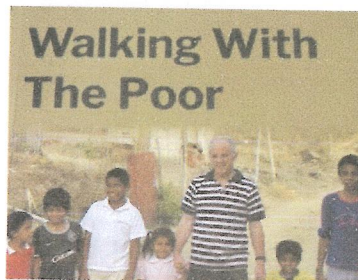
There will be Easter Sunday Vespers in the Cathedral at 4pm on Easter day to conclude the Easter Triduum.



On Holy Thursday in all three parishes we shall include the washing of feet in the liturgy. Would you be willing to have your feet washed on this evening? Please let me know if you would. You will not have to come up

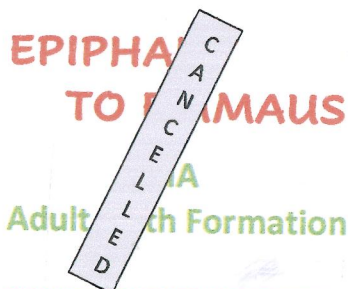
on to the Sanctuary: the Bishop or myself will walk among you and wash the feet where you are at the end of your bench.

The foot washing ritual is open to women and men, young and old.
