Last Sunday at Jacob's well, we rediscovered how we thirst for the Christ, how the *bucket* of our lives can leak and like the woman of Samaria how we must let the Messiah encounter the reality of our lives, so we can know him more deeply as the *Living Water* and the *Saviour of the world*.

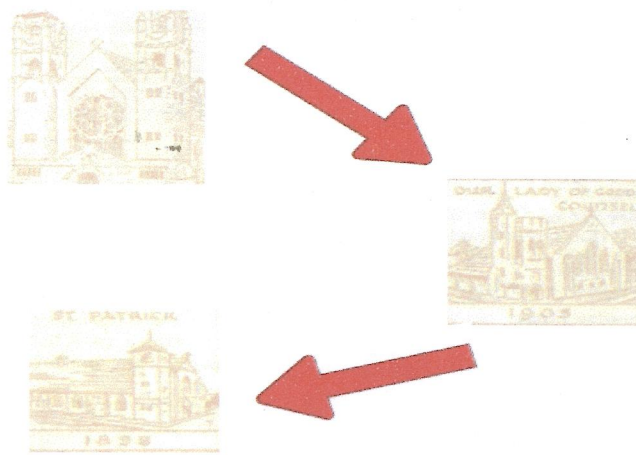
Next Sunday as the raising of Lazarus is read we will encounter Christ as Resurrection and Life, and today we are "walking along" with Jesus as the text says, and we move from darkness, to light in him.

Here light triumphs over the darkness not only of the lack of physical sight but of spiritual error and refusal to believe; for Jesus is revealed as light of the world. As he has been *living water* for the Samaritans with their unexpected evangeliser, the Woman of last Sunday, so too this beggar who up till now would have been abandoned to his fate, hobbling through life, judged – even by the disciples of Jesus at this stage - as being an object of God's punishment for some sin of his parents or his own, he will become a model of true worship in spirit and truth espoused by last Sunday's Gospel.

Enjoy the Mass we share this Sunday!

This Sunday, I will celebrate the Vigil Mass in the Ferry, the 9.30am in St Patrick's, the 11am Solemn Mass in the Cathedral, and the evening Mass in the Cathedral. Bishop Stephen will be in St. Mary's, Forebank, and Monsignor Ken McCaffrey will be in Broughty Ferry for the 9.45am Mass.
