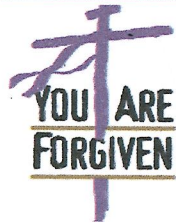

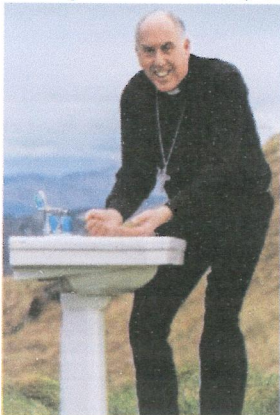

International Aid Fund this Sunday, one of the causes so close to our hearts here in the Church in Scotland. Please be as generous as you can.

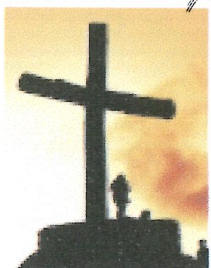
Bishop Brian McGee, the Bishop president of the Scottish Catholic International Aid Fund (SCIAF), recently climbed a hill (while carrying a sink!) overlooking Oban, to bring attention to the annual Lent WEE BOX Appeal which is raising funds for local organisations in Ethiopia to bring clean water to communities and help people lift themselves out of poverty.



Bishop McGee, who was moved to action after a visit to Ethiopia, said: "In Scotland, we are blessed with some of the finest water in the world. We bathe in it, use it for cooking, and drink as much as we want, whenever we want. We take it for granted that it will always be there.

Water is life. But for many, it's dangerously scarce. In Ethiopia far too many women, girls, and boys still have to walk for hours every day under the scorching sun. This means missed days at school, getting sick from dirty water, and in some places taking their lives in their hands just to reach water."

Thirsting for Light and Life

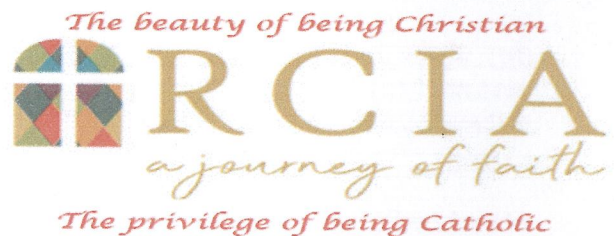
